

STEM Family Member/Caregiver Survey Data

Survey Instructions November 2017-October 2018 Year Three

GUIDANCE ON SURVEYING FAMILY MEMBERS/CAREGIVERS:

- The VELI-STEM grant calls for evaluating family member/caregiver perceptions of the impact of library STEM programming on the young child(ren) they accompany to programs and on themselves.
- To measure this, librarians will encourage family members/caregivers who participate in each and every *STEM program to complete a survey (just as you do with child care providers/early educators after STEM programs).
 - *NOTE: If a STEM program is conducted over the course of more than one session, only ask family members/caregivers to complete a survey at the conclusion of all sessions.
- The term "family member/caregiver" is used to encompass a variety of adults who might accompany 3-7-year-old children to STEM programming, beyond just parents (e.g., nannies, grandparents, neighbors, friends' parents).
- Please plan to announce at the beginning of each STEM Program that a very brief survey will be given
 at the end. You may want to allocate approximately 10 minutes at the end of the program for a snack
 or a short activity to keep children engaged while the family members/caregivers complete the
 survey.
- The Year Three surveying period for family members/caregivers is November 2017 through October 2018.

- All surveys must be completed/entered by October 31, 2018.
